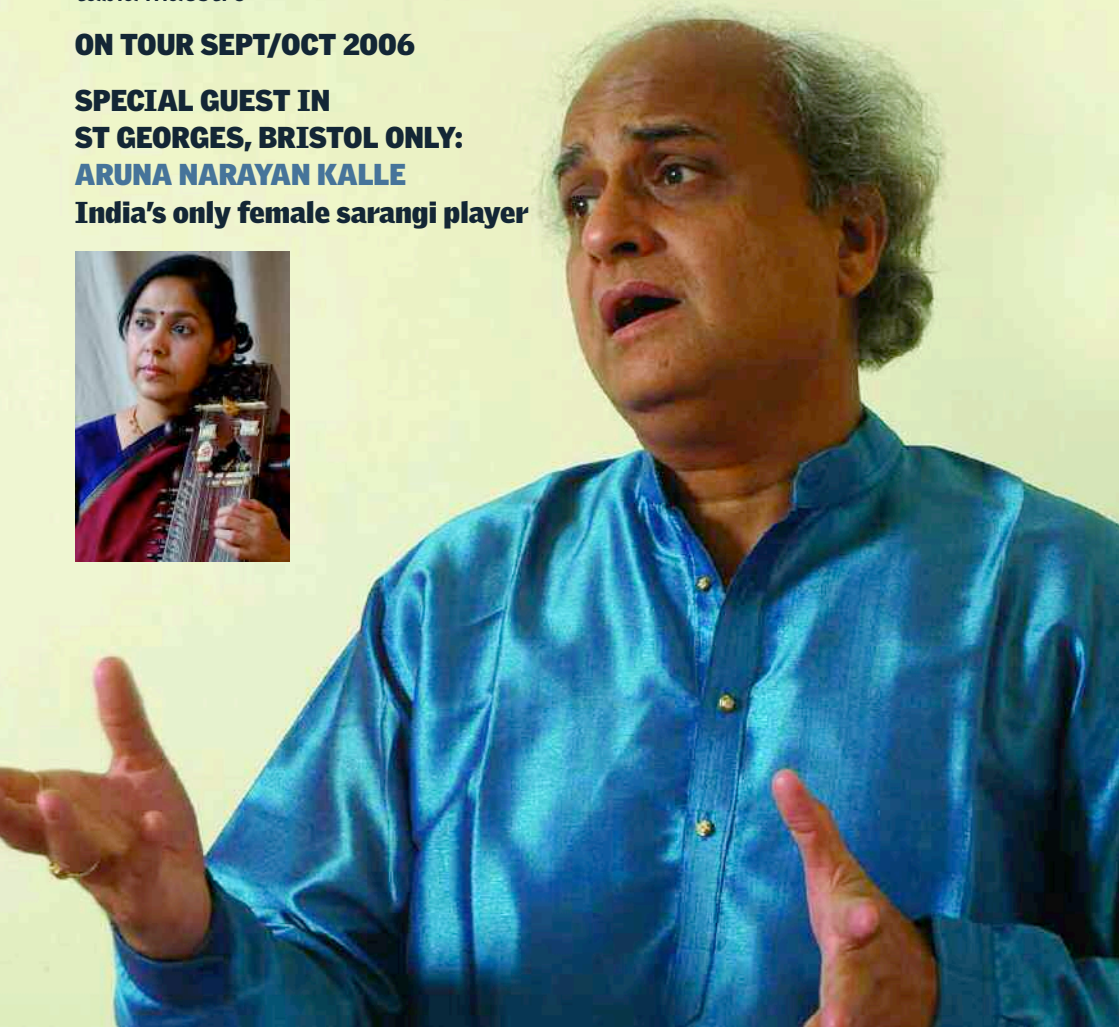

In an age when maestros of the older generation express fear of the decadence of our grand tradition, Ulhas Kashalkar's voice and music stands like the phoenix, as it were, an eternal reminder of the strength of this great art. His performances offer a unique glimpse into the integrity and beauty of North Indian classical music.

Representing the Jaipur vocal tradition with its very clear, clean and bold musical lines, Ulhas Kashalkar is also adept in other styles such as the Gwalior and Agra gharanas. Beautiful compositions (bandishes) interspersed with superb and varied improvisations and TAANS (fast and virtuosic passages) are characteristic of this wonderful artist.

To complement this, in Suresh Talwalkar we have one of the world's finest and rarest tabla players today, who is a great soloist in the old tradition and who has not yet given in to the contemporary renditions now used in fusion music. Accompanied by the highly acclaimed UK-based harmonium player and talented vocalist Chiranjib Chakraborty.

The 4 Oct concert at St Georges, Bristol is a double bill shared with Aruna Narayan Kalle, the daughter of the illustrious sarangi maestro Pandit Ramnarayan. Aruna is the only female sarangi player in India.
